Hilda was born in Kohumaru on the 7th day of June 1931, the 3rd of 9 children to Hazel and Norton Jobe.

At the tender age of 17 she met her future husband to be, Monty James Enright in the small country town of Kaitaia where Monty worked as a barman. From there they moved to a tiny settlement in Pawarenga, the hometown of Monty's parents Jim and Susan Enright. They were then married in the Rotokakahi church, and went onto enjoy a wonderful life together.



After living there for a short period of approximately four months they then moved to the big city of Auckland in Sale St where they resided with Hilda's mother Hazel Jobe.



Three years down the track they had their first daughter Dianne and then moved to a farm in Helensville where Monty worked share-milking and running dry-stock.

The next move was a house in Mangere where the next three daughters were born – Beverley, Raewyn and Leonie until finally they purchased their first home in Glen Innes where they lived until the four girls left home.



For many years they enjoyed happy times with family and friends in Mangawhai Heads where they purchased a small piece of land and built their holiday home which would eventually become their permanent residence.

Sadly this is where Hilda's journey ends aged 82 years on 9th March 2014
